# LGPE (Large Group Performance Evaluation)

LGPE is a state wide evaluation that all traditional band programs participate in. It is an event where bands perform a selection of pieces for judges and will be provided with feedback for how the program can continue to grow and develop. There are various ratings assigned to the bands after their performance. (Superior, Excellent, Good, Fair, Poor).

Our LGPE will be held at Southwest Dekalb High School and I am strongly encouraging all parents to attend this event! The more support and bodies we have in the audience, the better the students will perform. I could also use some chaperones to ride the bus for that event as well.

We will be taking school buses to the event and students will be staying after school. We will be leaving school around 4pm. More information will be given soon!

For any students who are not prepared on the music by concert time, will be asked to complete an alternative assignment to make up the grades.

Students are expected to practice at least 20 minutes every day from this point forward. Students, think about how long you spend on your other homework assignments for your ap classes... I ask that you do your band "homework" by practicing every day. Individual practice is the key for our large group success. Parents, please help encourage your child to practice at home every week—yes they have "homework" in band!!

Please note that all concerts and after school rehearsals are mandatory. Students will be evaluated and given an assessment grade for these events. There will be no alternative assignments given to any students who skip any event(s) without communication to Ms.Caputo.
